Fungicide application recommendations for disease management on greens in the Midwest are selected primarily for the control of anthracnose, dollar spot, Summer patch and brown patch. Mid-summer preventive applications for Pythium foliar blight are also included in the program.

Golf courses with annual bluegrass and creeping bentgrass putting greens are at risk of development of anthracnose and dollar spot starting in early May and persisting throughout the summer months into early fall. Although applications for the control of snow mold are not included in the program, preventive spray programs for pink and gray snow mold prior to snow cover are warranted.
